FDR Turns Up the Heat.

During Fire Side Chat.

Sunday marked a great day in American history as President Roosevelt shattered illusions and informed the American people that Germans have been spotted in the Gulf of Mexico. He stated *“The Germans objective is to see how close they can come to our GREAT LAND before we will take action!”*

These words shocked millions of Americans as they listened to the Fire side chat on CBS Radio. Roosevelt continued to state *“At this time, when the world -- and the world including our own American Hemisphere -- when the world is threatened by forces of destruction, it is my resolve and yours to build up our armed defenses.”* His plan is to increase production of military weapons and vessels to ensure that America remains safe.

During a follow up session with reporters, the President said his plan is to deter any nation from thinking about attacking our nation.



Remove Social Security and Reduce Minimum Wage!!

Some groups in Washington are speculating that Roosevelt will ask Congress to lower the minimum wage and divert Social Security from the elderly to the increased Defense of the nation. When confronted directly about this issue Roosevelt stated *“We should bring more citizens under the coverage of old-age pensions and unemployment insurance. At the same time, we should plan a better system by which persons deserving or needing gainful employment may obtain it. The more people that are employed the better the nation and the greater the production output can be obtained. At the same time I would like to see us widen the opportunities for adequate medical care.”* The president went on to explain that the healthier the people of the nation are the more prepared we will be for the future.

The State of the Union Address on Thursday will shed more light on the president's plans for defending the nation and by what means he will acquire the financial backing from congress.
