## Russian Front Collapses

More news comes from captured Russian prisoners. The Russian army is having major moral problems as vast numbers are dropping their arms and returning home. The Russian army leadership appears to be at a total loss on how to stop them.

In an effort to distract the Russian people and its military leadership Russia is starting trouble with Finland with border hostilities. Several skirmishes have been reported for yet another month. How long will Finland put up with this injustice is unknown.

## Luftwaffe strikes deep

Elements of the German Airforce in conjunction with ground troops over the past few months have struck deep into Russia taking out airfields and command centers with many tactical strikes that have caused havoc in the front lines. Gaping holes in the Russian lines are now being reported by local army commanders.

## Battle in the Atlantic

The Battle for the Atlantic continues. The Tirpitz undaunted by the odds takes on the British home fleet. In a series of Naval actions roughly 20 enemy combat vessels have been reported sunk or heavily damaged. In addition to those losses some 500K tons of Allied merchant shipping have also been reported to be sunk by the Tirpitz and sub forces operating in that area.

In the end the crew of the Tirpitz scuttled the ship and took to the life boats when the ammunition was consumed and the ship was severely damaged.

The Captain and crew will always be remembered as heroes to the Fatherland.
